

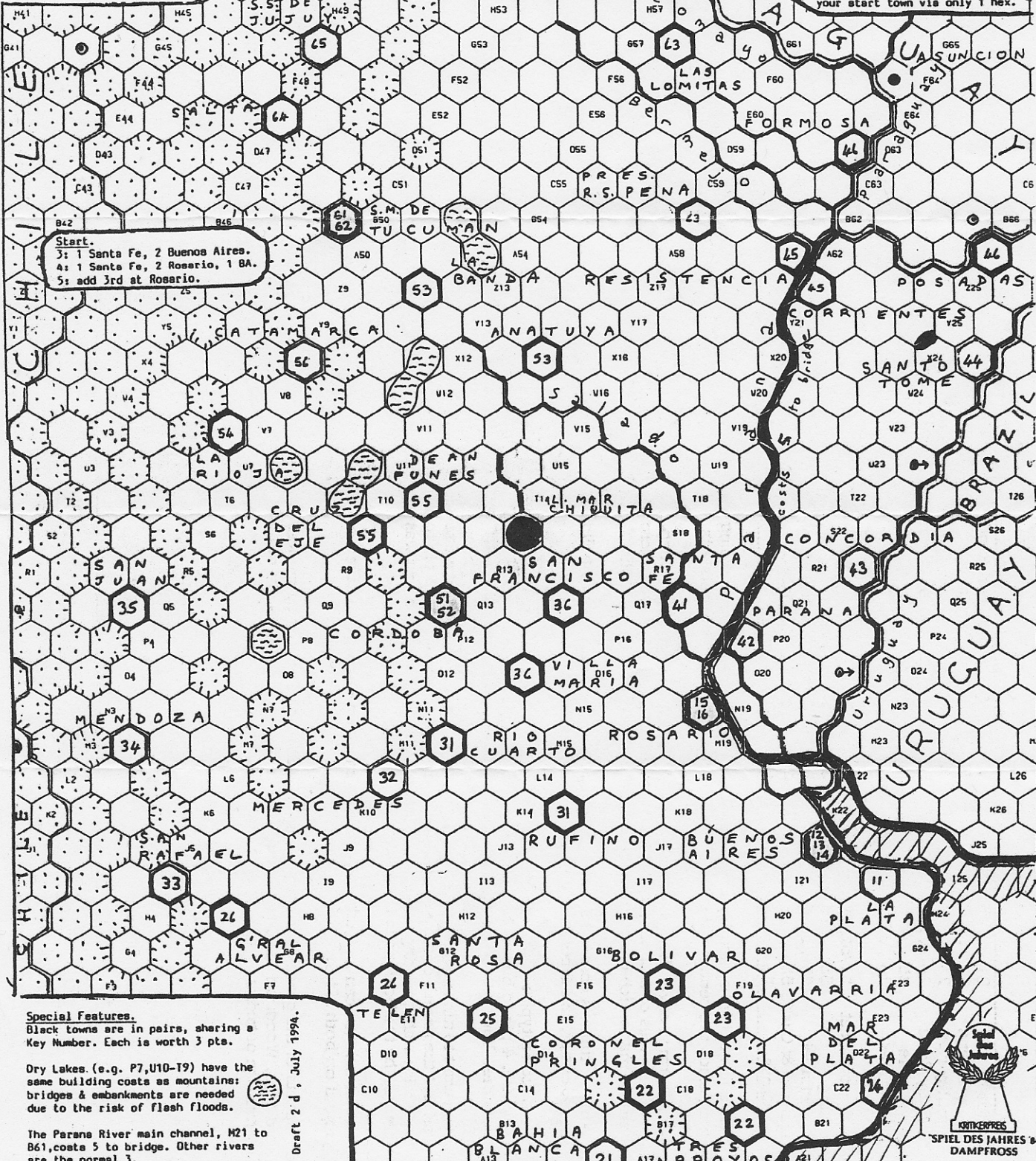
RAILWAY RIVALS MAP AG ARGENTINA

SCALE: 1 HEX = 60 KM
(APPROX. 37 MILES)

In the first turn, you can leave your start town via only 1 hex.

- Special Runs.**
 1 = Chile (M1 or G43).
 2 = Bolivia (M48 or M53).
 3 = Paraguay (D65 only).
 4 = Brazil (U24 or S.Tome).
 5 = Uruguay (U22, Concordia).
 6 = Seaport (Buenos Aires, La Plata, Bahia Blanca).

4 & 5 : connection points are ferry ports.



Start.
 3: 1 Santa Fe, 2 Buenos Aires.
 4: 1 Santa Fe, 2 Rosario, 1 BA.
 5: add 3rd at Rosario.

Special Features.
 Black towns are in pairs, sharing a Key Number. Each is worth 3 pts.

Dry Lakes (e.g. P7, U10-19) have the same building costs as mountains: bridges & embankments are needed due to the risk of flash floods.

The Parana River main channel, M21 to B61, costs 5 to bridge. Other rivers are the normal 3.
