**START:** 3 players: all start Boston.  
 4 to 6 players: Boston, or New York State [at hexes listed below].

**SPECIAL RUNS:** 1 or 2 : New York: B2, F2, M3, E44, K45. 3: Vermont: J46 or J51.  
 4 or 5: New Hampshire: J52, J54, J55, J58, J60, K63, L64, L66. 6: Any coast town.

Some large towns very close together in the S and E have been omitted [e.g. Holyoke, Cambridge] while smaller towns which were important junctions in the hilly NW are included. No rivers are marked, as even [unmarked] estuaries did not seem to affect rail development much.

*Railway Rivals* was first published by D G Watts in 1973. It is one of several 'Rostherne Games', now belonging to Mr T Clark, 24 Anglesea Rd, IPSWICH IP 1 3 PP: 01473 280 310. Details of the commercial game can be obtained from Mr Clarke.
