



Railway Rivals: Map TV: Taff Vale

You may build to Docks only along the dotted lines; e.g. K70 & L69 to Cardiff Dock

Scale 1 hex = 1.25 Km [0.8 Miles] up the map, but 1.1 Km [0.7 Miles] sideways.

Start 3 players; all start at Cardiff City Centre. 4 players: 3 at Cardiff, 1 at Barry.

Runs these will be alternate normal [town to town] and special runs:

- 1: To Cardiff Dock. 2: To Barry Dock. 3 or 4: To any dock.
- 4: To England: Cardiff City centre, N60, N55, or M42.
- 6: To the rest of Wales: A26, A23, A19, A17, A8, D41, or Hirwaun.

This map is only suitable for 3 or 4 players. 'Leapfrog' rules are essential.
