Start. Players may start at any town they wish.

Special Runs

- 1 = NE (Darlington or Stockton)
- 2 = major seaport (Middlesbrough, Hull, Grimsby)
- 3 = seaside resort (Whitby, Filey, Scarborough, Bridlington, Hornsea, Withernsea and Grimsby-for Cleethorpes)
- 4 = the South: Sheffield, Grimsby or any hex from A15 - A25.
- 5 = Lancashire: R4, J4, H5, E8, A11.
- 6 = NW: B52 or H54.

Humber Ferry: usual ferry rules, except that the ferry can be purchased only by a player reaching K29. The ferry owner cannot build on from Hull, except of course if he also already has a Hull rail link.

The map includes the following counties, or parts of them: W. Yorkshire, S. Yorkshire, N. Yorkshire, Cleveland, Humberside, Lincolnshire, and Durham. County boundaries are not shown.
